Clean up day	Clean up trash and recyclable materials around each school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare the amount of trash collected in St. Louis and Kalama • Compare what is recycled in each country • Have the students create “junk sculptures” from the materials collected and give prizes to the most creative students • List for what the natural resources in each community are used
Soil Erosion	Use a small landscape model to show the effects of erosion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What can you as a kid do about soil erosion? • Have the students in each country describe how soil erosion affects their community • Show pictures of the soil erosion in Kalama
Tree planting	Plant trees around the school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare the types of trees found in each community • Compare what trees are used for in Kalama and St. Louis • Discuss what products come from trees, how the students can reduce their usage of these products
Bird houses and feeders	Construct bird houses and feeders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Compare the different types of birds found in each area • Compare the types of houses and feeders the students in each country built • Discuss how to make your school more “bird friendly”
