

Polar Bears of Churchill



An Exclusive Trip for the Saint Louis Zoo

Experience the thrill of seeing polar bears living freely in their own natural habitat! Every fall, the tundra surrounding Churchill, Manitoba, becomes a stopover for more than 1,000 polar bears on their annual migration to hunt for food on the ice floes of Hudson Bay.

Your northern adventure will allow plenty of opportunity to view bears at close range from the warmth and comfort of special tundra vehicles. You will often see mothers and cubs, as well as young adult males play fighting. This incredible experience is becoming rare as polar bears face the growing threat of extinction because their fragile sea ice habitat is disappearing due to global climate change. You'll also have an opportunity to look for gyrfalcons, snowy owls, ptarmigans, Arctic foxes and other tundra wildlife. Experienced naturalists will interpret the animals' behaviors and their adaptations to the hostile Arctic environment, both during our field excursions and in evening presentations. Other trip offerings include exploring Winnipeg and the Manitoba Museum, a night-time trip to the tundra, an opportunity to explore the remote

and intriguing town of Churchill, and the possibility of seeing the Northern Lights.

Your tour operator, Natural Habitat Adventures has been a leader in worldwide ecotourism and responsible nature travel for over 20 years. This is the fourth Polar Bears of Churchill trip the Saint Louis Zoo has conducted through Natural Habitat Adventures. We are confident your experience will exceed your expectations.

Trip activity level: This is an easy trip with short walks on level ground, but expect very cold temperatures on the tundra.

Be sure to sign up early for this special eight day trip as Polar Bear trips are extremely popular. The trip is limited to 15 participants.

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 13

St. Louis / Winnipeg, Manitoba

Upon arrival at Winnipeg Airport, your Natural Habitat Adventures representative will pick you up and transfer you downtown to Hotel Fort Garry for your night's stay. After checking in, you are free to relax or explore Winnipeg until you gather for an informal dinner in our hotel. **D**

SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 14

Winnipeg

After breakfast you will depart for the Manitoba Museum. The "Inuit: People of the North" interactive program will give us an understanding of the traditional lifestyles of the Inuit people. Your guided museum tour tells the story of Manitoba through the ages, from the northern Arctic coast to the southern prairie grasslands. After lunch, you tour the city and arrive back to enjoy the "Fire in the Sky" planetarium presentation about the Northern Lights. We arrive back at Hotel Fort Garry for our trip orientation dinner at 7:00 pm. **B, L, D**

MONDAY, NOVEMBER 15

Winnipeg / Churchill

After breakfast, you fly to Churchill (about a 3-hour flight). Upon arrival in Churchill, you will have a brief tour of the town and settle into your hotel accommodations for the next four nights. You will be free this afternoon to explore the town of Churchill on your own. This evening, we will be briefed with a slide show on polar bears and our upcoming adventures. **B, L, D**

TUESDAY & WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 16 & 17

Churchill / Bear Viewing

You will spend the next two days exploring the Arctic environment in our tundra vehicles as your guides interpret the polar bear's natural history, behavior and their conservation issues as well as tundra ecology. After a hearty breakfast, you travel outside of town by bus to a special boarding site at the edge of the tundra to find our polar buggies. Your journey takes you along glacially-formed natural roadways to the icy coastline of the Hudson Bay where the bears tend to gather.

This is the only time of year that the bears tolerate each other's presence, and their interactions are intriguing. You



may encounter young bears mock-fighting. Although ferocious looking, this play activity actually helps prepare the bears for the hostile environment of the pack ice. An adult male may turn his attention towards us, sometimes approaching within feet, and even lift his massive paws on the side of our vehicle to peer inside. (Don't worry – you're quite safe inside the buggy!)

While on the tundra, you may also see a variety of other northern wildlife, including Arctic fox, snowy owl, ptarmigan and gyrfalcon. You will return to town in the late afternoon to relax before dinner. Depending on the activities of the day, our free evenings will include wildlife or cultural presentations, slide shows or time to relax at your leisure. **B, L, D**



THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 18

Churchill / Evening on the Tundra

Today you will have a full-day guided tour of historic Churchill and then, in the evening, we head out to the tundra. You will enjoy dinner in our vehicle and see the Arctic animals in an atmosphere rarely experienced by most visitors. If you chance upon a clear night, the Northern Lights may appear and brighten the entire sky. You return late in the evening. **B, L, D**

FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 19

Churchill / Winnipeg

Depending on flight schedules, you may have some free time this morning to explore Churchill and shop for Arctic souvenirs, or to participate in an optional helicopter excursion or dog sledding excursion before returning to Winnipeg. Today you will have either a farewell lunch in Churchill or dinner in Winnipeg depending on flight schedules. Our final night will be at the Hotel Fort Garry. **B, L or D**

SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 20

Winnipeg / St. Louis

After breakfast, you will transfer to the airport for the return flight home. **B**

However, the animals we visit live wild and free and we cannot fully predict or control their migratory patterns (nor would we want to). In an attempt to locate wildlife that may have deviated from its normal pattern, or in the interest of traveler comfort or safety, we may be required to make reasonable changes in itineraries. If it is necessary to change hotels, boats, other facilities and/or program leaders, comparable accommodations will be substituted wherever possible. If such changes or fluctuations in exchange rates occur, additional costs may require the program fee to change with little or no notice.

REFUND AND CANCELLATION POLICY

Should NHA be required to cancel a trip due to unforeseen circumstances, travelers will be refunded for their trip cost, but NHA will not be liable for accompanying expenses (such as gear purchases, airline tickets, etc.).
